Dear brethren,

Our study tonight will be another saved talk delivered by Bettie's late husband Willard, back in 2007 in Dallas that was entitled "Your Part In The Body".

In a recent email exchange (below), the background story of an egregious split, this time with Ray Smith and brothers whom Willard and Bettie, Mike and Sandi, had known for a long long time.

The message is an important one for us to hear and this email below should amplify this admonition to take heed with gladness and with fear.

Mal 3:16 Then they that feared the LORD spake often one to another: and the LORD hearkened, and heard it, and a book of remembrance was written before him for them that feared the LORD, and that thought upon his name.

Heb 10:25 Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.

Begin forwarded message:

Sandi and I thank the Lord for Bettie and Willard also. When Ray got around to doing to me what he had already done to Willard, Bettie and Willard stood by us when 90% of those on our mailing list agreed with Ray that God's elect do not fulfill the seven last plagues of the wrath of God in spite of what the scriptures tell us and in spite of me pointing to these verses at that time:

Rev 15:7 And one of the four beasts gave unto the seven angels seven golden vials **full of the wrath of God**, who liveth for ever and ever.

Rev 15:8 And the temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God, and from his power; and <u>no man was able to enter into the temple</u>, till the seven plagues of the seven angels were fulfilled.

Rev 15:7 And one of the four beasts gave unto the seven angels seven golden vials full of the wrath of God, who liveth for ever and ever.

Rev 15:8 And the temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God, and from his power; and <u>no man</u> was able to enter into the temple, <u>till the seven plagues</u> <u>of the seven angels were fulfilled.</u>

Those were very hard times. Just as our last apostasy, after years of agreeing that we all had to 'read, hear, and keep the things written therein', there was a sudden change of doctrine and those who fell away accused the few who remained faithful of leaving the original doctrine:

Rev 1:3 Blessed is he that <u>readeth</u>, and they that <u>hear</u> the words of this prophecy, <u>and keep</u> those things which are written therein: for the time is at hand.

The Truth was the exact opposite but the vast majority of those coming to Ray's site agreed with him and put those who held to the Truth "out of the church", just as they did in the days of the apostles:

But the Lord knows all those who are His sheep, and His sheep know His 'voice', His Words, His Truth and as His sheep we 'flee from the voice of a stranger':

3Jn 1:9 I wrote unto the church: but Diotrephes, who loveth to have the preeminence among them, receiveth us not.

3Jn 1:10 Wherefore, if I come, I will remember his deeds which he doeth, prating against us with malicious words: and not content therewith, neither doth he himself receive the brethren, and forbiddeth them that would, **and casteth them out of the church.**

Joh 10:4 And when he putteth forth his own sheep, he goeth before them, and the sheep follow him: for they know his voice.

Joh 10:5 And a stranger will they not follow, **but will flee from him**: for they know not the voice of strangers.

Bettie and Willard proved to be of the Lord's 7 thousand who had not bowed the knew to Baal, and they remained faithful to the Lord's "voice" through that time of great trial. That meant more to Sandi and to me at the time than they realized and Willard remained "faithful... to the end", as I pray we all will.

You and a few others have also weathered some very bad spiritual 'storms' over

the years and the Lord has always brought us through those storms and to Himself... to our "rest" and "unto [our] desired haven".

Psa 107:21 Oh that men would praise the LORD for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men!

Psa 107:22 And let them sacrifice the sacrifices of thanksgiving, and declare his works with rejoicing.

Psa 107:23 They that go down to the sea in ships, that do business in great waters;

Psa 107:24 These see the works of the LORD, and his wonders in the deep.

Psa 107:25 For he commandeth, and raiseth the stormy wind, which lifteth up the waves thereof.

Psa 107:26 They mount up to the heaven, they go down again to the depths: their soul is melted because of trouble.

Psa 107:27 They reel to and fro, and stagger like a drunken man, and are at their wits' end.

Psa 107:28 **Then** they cry unto the LORD in their trouble, and he bringeth them out of their distresses.

Psa 107:29 He maketh the storm a calm, so that the waves thereof are still.

Psa 107:30 **Then** are they glad because they be quiet; **so he bringeth them unto their desired haven.**

Psa 107:31 Oh that men would praise the LORD for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men!

Heb 4:10 For he that <u>is entered into his rest</u>, he also hath <u>ceased from his</u> <u>own works</u>, as God did from his.

Sandi and I continue with all of you to seek to "enter into His rest", and to "sacrifice the sacrifice of thanksgiving" for all the Lord is doing in and through His body,
